TEAM

Brings together a group of people

Public, private or org-wide

Can be archived

Add apps to extend functionality

Team members have access to all channels, unless you make them private

Has its own email address (Group mailbox)

Max 5000 people per Team

Drag & drop Teams to change the order

Create Team based on a template

Max 500.000 Teams

CHANNEL

Dedicated sections within a Team

Standard or private

Can't be archived separate from the Team

Add tabs to extend functionality

Private channels for selected Team members

Each channel has it's own email address

Pin channels to the top

Listed in alphabetic order (use numbers if you want to define your own order)

Max 200 standard channels per Team
+ 30 private channels

REALDOLMEN BUSINESS CASE // MANAGE TEAMS: PRIVATE CHANNELS

- Restrict a channel to specific members of the Team
- Owners can see all channels but need to be a member of the private channel to access it
- Members can only see channels they have access to
- No wiki or planner
- Provisions a new site collection in SharePoint
- Private site collections not visible in admin center
- Before private channels: new private Teams created
- Educate users on when and how to use what
- Rollout postponed at Realdolmen until governance is clear

Privacy

Private – Only accessible to a specific group of people within the team

Standard – Accessible to everyone on the team

Private – Only accessible to a specific group of people within the team

REALDOLMEN BUSINESS CASE // ARCHIVE TEAMS

- Not promoted within Realdolmen
(Move files to SharePoint portal – delete Team)
- Use if you're not sure content can already be deleted
- Only Team owners or admins can archive Teams
- You can:
 - ▶ Add/remove members
 - ▶ Read all files and conversations
 - ▶ Update files when SharePoint site is NOT set to read-only
 - ▶ Unarchive the Team anytime
 - ▶ Show/hide in your favorite Teams
- You can't:
 - ▶ Update files when SharePoint site is set to read-only
 - ▶ Reply/start conversations



REALDOLMEN BUSINESS CASE // DELETE TEAMS

- Based on expiration policy or manually delete
- Only Team owners or admins can delete Teams
- 30 days to restore a Team with all content
- If you don't use an expiration policy, Teams might be there forever
- Keep your environment clean
- Move final documents to SharePoint



REALDOLMEN BUSINESS CASE // THE GOOD & BAD



- Less email
- Recordable meetings
- Clear view on when to use what
 - MS Teams = collaboration
 - SharePoint = final/public information
 - Yammer = knowledge & interest groups
- Notifications - @mentions
- Organization chart
- User adoption
- MS Teams mobile app
- New features - Roadmap



- Teams client doesn't work offline
- No metadata in files tab
- Public Teams files are shown in Delve suggestions
- Reply vs new conversation
- New features

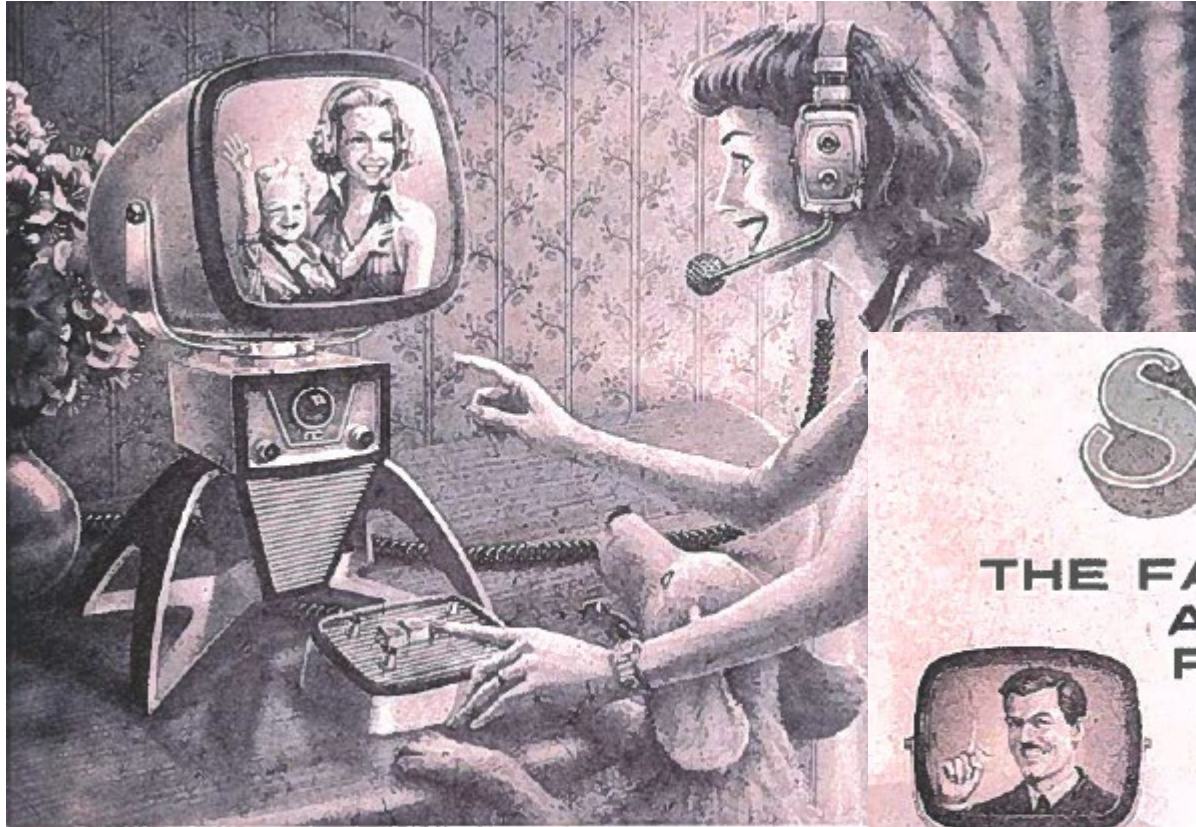

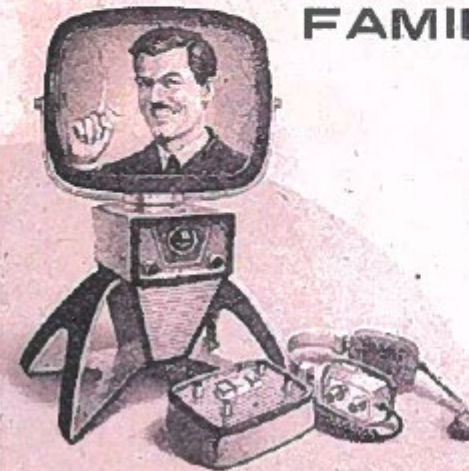

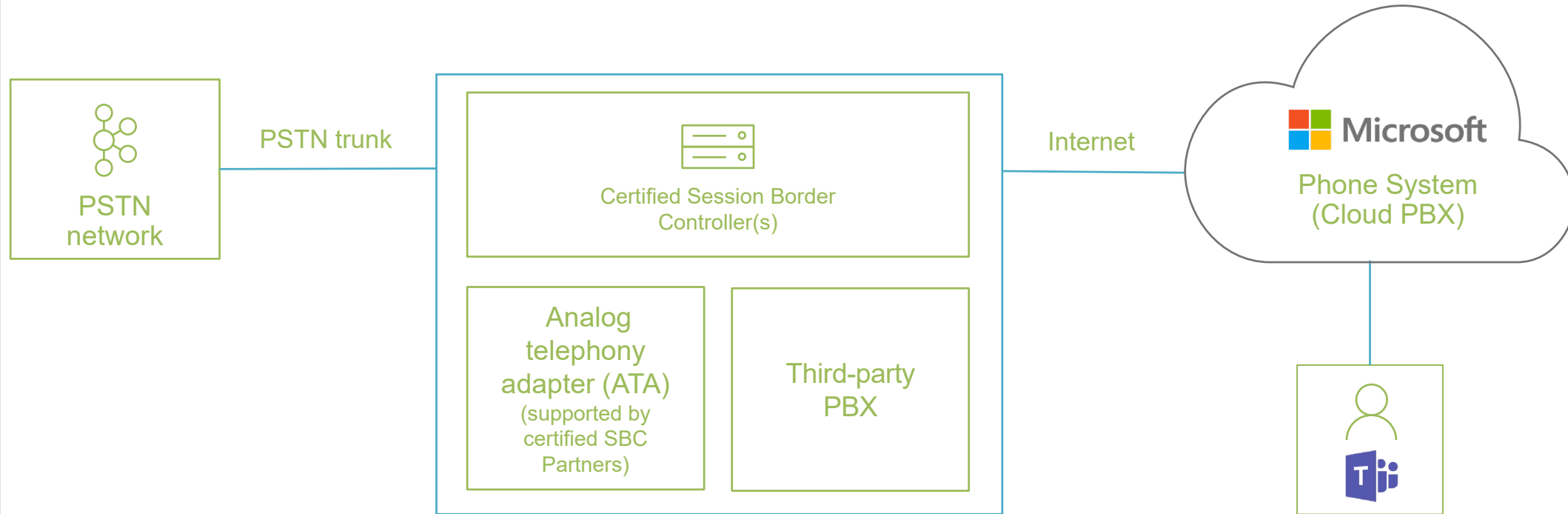

PATHS TO TEAMS

- Starting point is Skype for Business
- End point is all users using Teams Only
- Driving adoption in your key scenarios in Teams is a critical success factor
- Key considerations when deciding your path:
 - ✓ Feature requirements & overlap between SFB and Teams
 - ✓ Moving users all at once or in cohorts
 - ✓ Velocity to move users to Teams Only

- Teams is customized, no collaboration (for now)

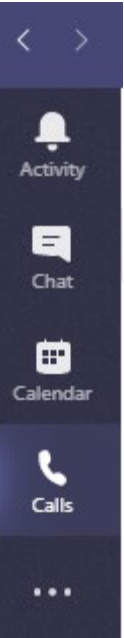
