THE AGREEMENT-OFFER OPTIONS FOR AZURE

- EA: Enterprise Agreement: add Azure to your existing Enterprise Agreement
 - Enterprise
 - Enterprise Dev/Test
- SCE: Server and Cloud Enrollment: "EA-like"
- MOSA: Microsoft website + credit card (aka MOSP or Web Direct)
 - Pay-as-you-go
 - Pay-as-you-go Dev/Test
- CSP: Cloud Solution Provider: end-to-end partner managed
 - Azure in CSP




